



CHOOSING THE RIGHT FAN

WHAT SIZE FAN SHOULD YOU GO WITH?

THE BEST RULE OF THUMB IS TO GO AS LARGE AS YOUR ROOM CAN ACCOMMODATE; FOR MAXIMUM AIRFLOW, YOU WANT AT LEAST 18 INCHES OF CLEARANCE BETWEEN THE EDGE OF THE BLADE AND YOUR WALL OR CEILING. HERE ARE A FEW SUGGESTIONS TO GUIDE YOU:
